

# Book Case Border Instructions

## Supplies\*:

- Cardboard
- 3 poster boards
- Magenta duct tape
- Lime green duct tape
- Teal duct tape
- Dark blue duct tape
- Purple duct tape
- Orange duct tape
- Yellow duct tape
- Removable tape



## Directions:

### Book Case Pattern 1

1. Cut two strips of poster board paper that measure 2" by 3', as shown in **Figure 1**.
2. Cover the two strips with the teal duct tape, as shown in **Figure 2**.
3. Out of cardboard, cut a piece that measures 3' (or the width of the book case) by 12", as shown in **Figure 3**.
4. Cover this piece with teal duct tape, as shown in **Figure 4**. This will be the monster's face.
5. Cut a 2" strip of cardboard that measures 3' 1", so it's slightly longer than the piece from Step 4. See **Figure 5**.

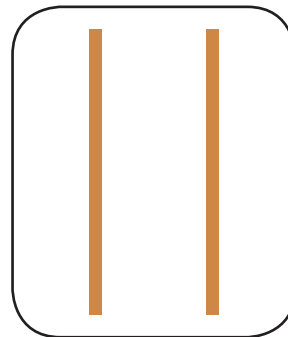

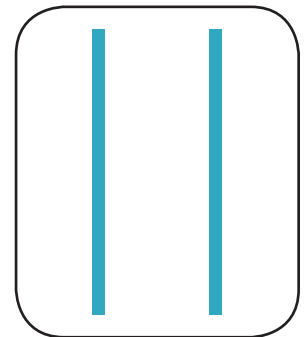

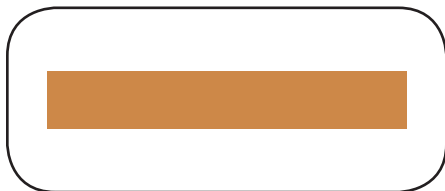

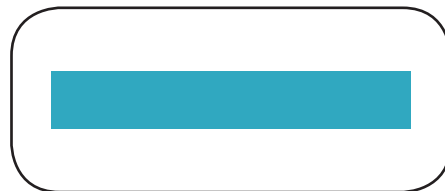

6. Cover the piece from Step 5 with the dark blue duct tape, as shown in **Figure 6**.
7. Cut two pieces similar in shape, as shown in **Figure 7**. These two pieces will be the teeth.
8. Glue the two pairs of teeth to the monster's face. See **Figure 8**.

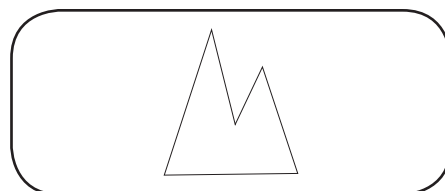

\*Remember, these are only suggestions. This should be fun and creative, so use supplies you have on hand for substitutions.

9. Glue the piece created in Step 5 along the bottom edge of the monster's face. See **Figure 9**.
10. For the eyes, cut out two trapezoids from the white poster board. Its longest side should roughly be 12". Cut a circle out of magenta paper that measures 6" in diameter, and a smaller 1" circle out of white paper. See **Figure 10**.
11. Glue the magenta circle to the center of the trapezoid, as shown in **Figure 11**.

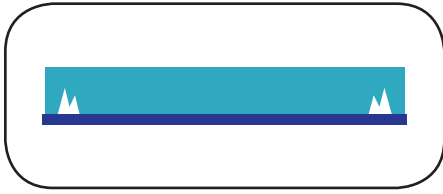

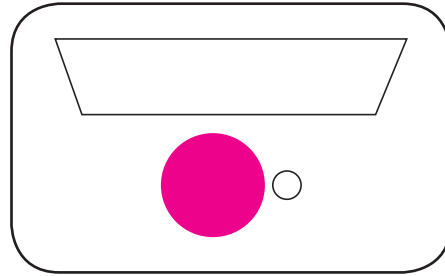

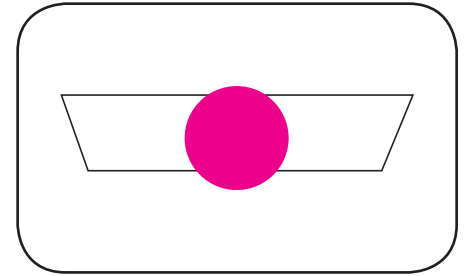

12. Glue the 1" white circle a little off of the magenta circle, as shown in **Figure 12**.
13. Cut off the excess magenta paper. See **Figure 13**.
14. Repeat Steps 11-13 to create the second eye.
15. Glue the eyes to the face, as shown in **Figure 14**.

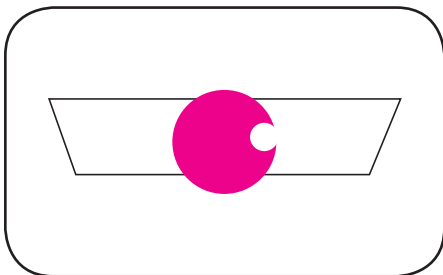

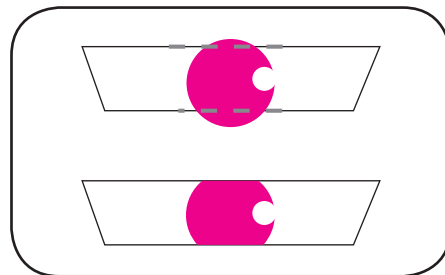

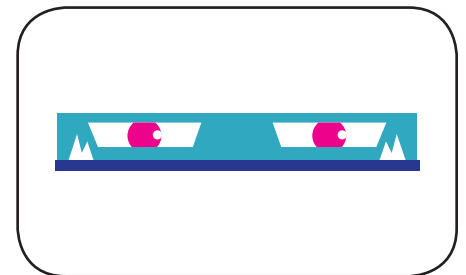

16. On the sides of the shelf, tape the two strips created earlier. See **Figure 15**.
17. Tape the monster's face to the top of the book case, as shown in **Figure 16**.
18. Remove decoration from cases once the Fair is over.

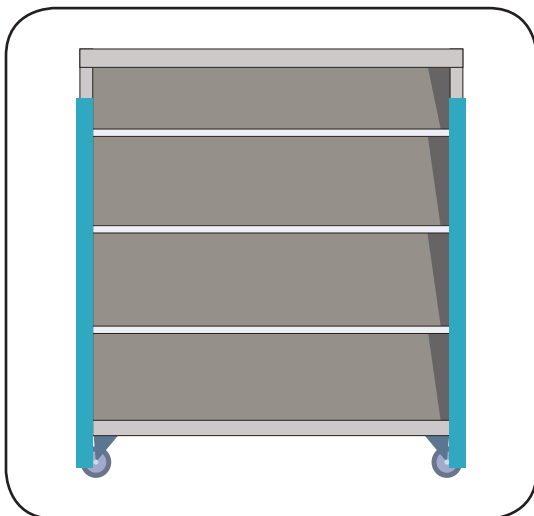

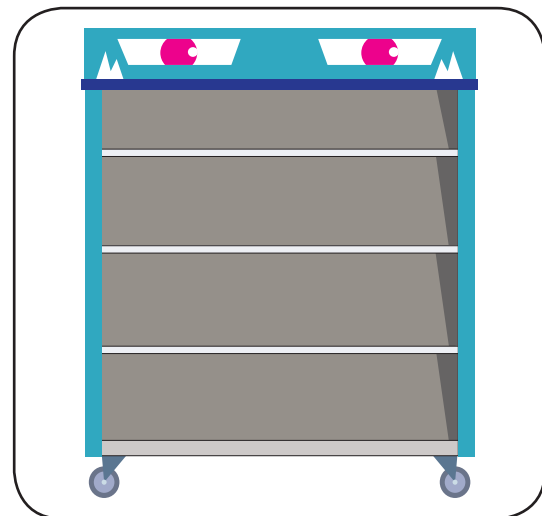

## Book Case Pattern 2

1. Cut two strips of poster board paper that measure 2" by 3', as shown in **Figure 1**.
2. Cover the two strips with the magenta duct tape, as shown in **Figure 2**.
3. Out of cardboard, cut a piece that measures 3' (or the width of the book case) by 12", as shown in **Figure 3**.
4. Cover this piece with magenta duct tape, as shown in **Figure 4**.
5. Cut an 8" in diameter circle out of cardboard. See **Figure 5**.

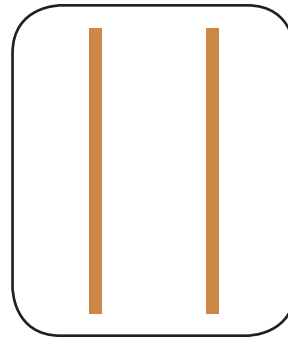

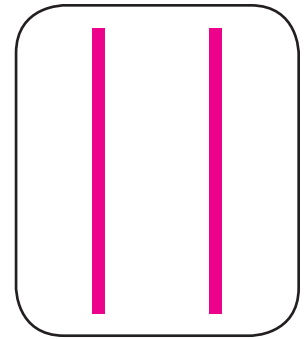

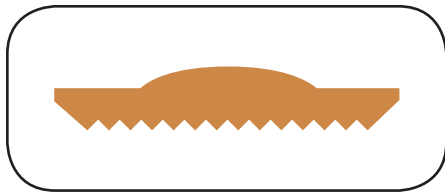

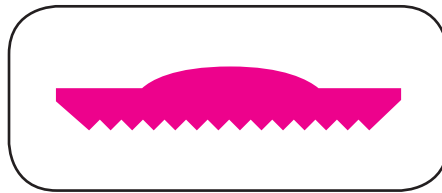

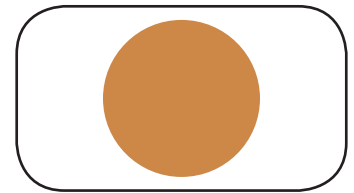

6. Cover the piece from Step 5 with the same magenta duct tape, as shown in **Figure 6**.
7. For the eyes, cut out a circle of white poster board that has a diameter of 6". Cut a circle out of green paper that measures 5" in diameter, and a smaller 1" circle out of white paper. See **Figure 7**.
8. Glue the pieces from Steps 6 and 7 together, as shown in **Figure 8**. This will be the eye.

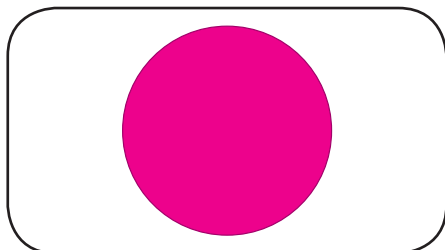

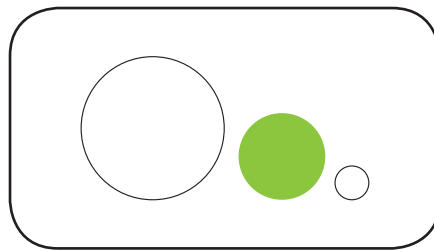

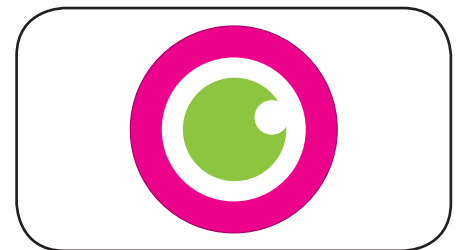

9. Glue the eye to the piece from Step 4. See **Figure 9**.
10. Assemble and affix to the shelf following the Steps 16-17 on page 2.

11. Remove decoration from cases once the Fair is over.

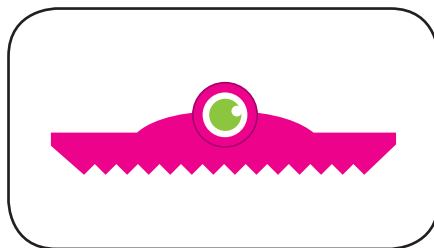

### Book Case Pattern 3

1. Cut two strips of poster board paper that measure 2" by 3", as shown in **Figure 1**.
2. Cover the two strips with the purple duct tape, as shown in **Figure 2**.
3. Out of cardboard, cut a piece that measures 3' (or the width of the book case) by 12", as shown in **Figure 3**.
4. Cover this piece with purple duct tape, as shown in **Figure 4**.

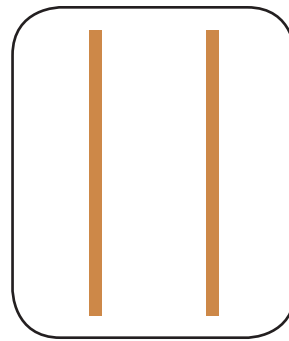

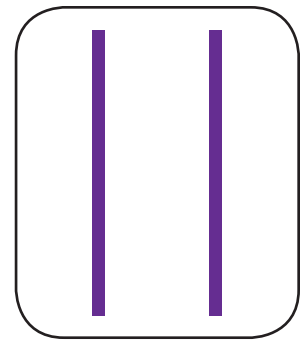

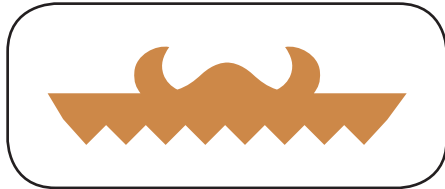

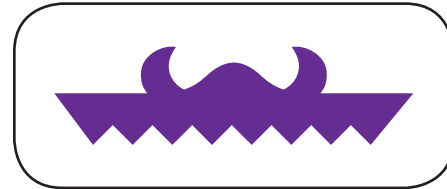

5. For the eyes, cut a circle out of white poster board that has a diameter of 2". Cut a circle out of orange paper that measures 1" in diameter, and a smaller .5" circle from white paper. See **Figure 5**.
6. Glue the pieces from Step 5 together, as shown in **Figure 6**. Repeat steps to make the second eye.
7. Glue the eyes to the piece from Step 4. See **Figure 7**.

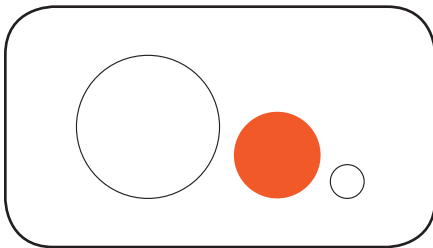

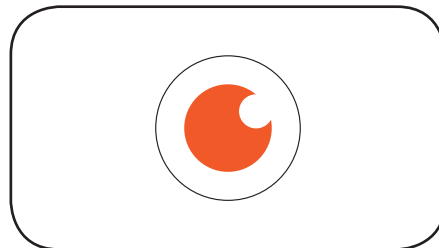

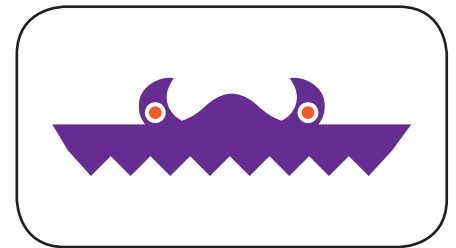

8. Assemble and affix to the shelf following Steps 16-17 on page 2.
9. Remove decoration from cases once the Fair is over.

## Book Case Pattern 4

1. Cut two strips of poster board paper that measure 2" by 3', as shown in **Figure 1**.
2. Cover the two strips with the orange duct tape, as shown in **Figure 2**.
3. Out of cardboard, cut a piece that measures 3' (or the width of the book case) by 12", similar to the shape in **Figure 3**.
4. Cover this piece with orange duct tape, as shown in **Figure 4**.
5. Cut a piece similar to the first piece in **Figure 5**. This piece should measure 1' wide and .5' tall. Cut a strip that measures 2" by 3'.

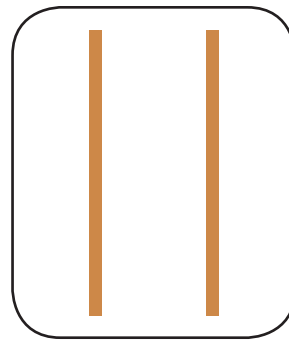

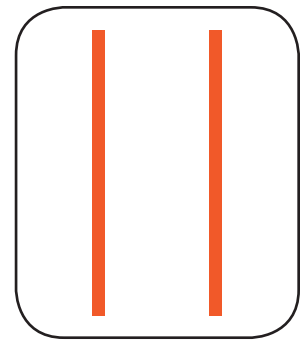

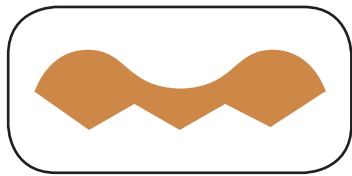

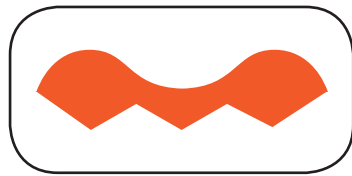

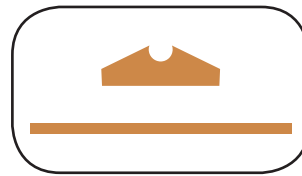

6. Cover the pieces from Step 5 with lime green duct tape, as shown in **Figure 6**.
7. Attach the top piece behind the piece from Step 4 so that it looks like the image in **Figure 7**.
8. For the eyes, cut out a circle of white poster board that has a diameter of 6". Cut a circle out of blue paper that measures 5" in diameter, and a smaller 1" circle from white paper. See **Figure 8**.
9. Glue the pieces from Step 8 together, as shown in **Figure 9**. Repeat steps to make the second eye.
10. Cut the circles a little over halfway down. See **Figures 10 and 11**.

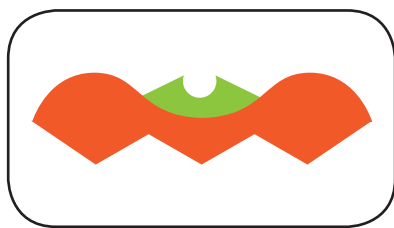

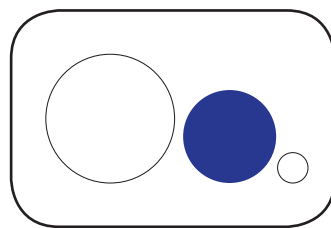

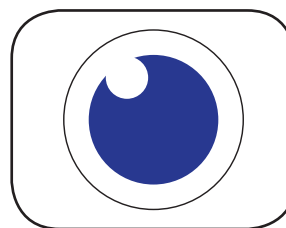

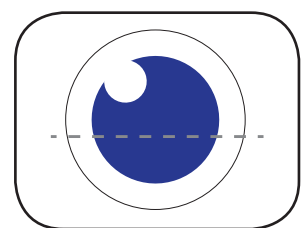

11. Glue the eyes to the piece from Step 4. See **Figure 12**.
12. Glue the strip from Step 5, lining up with the bottoms of the eyes. See **Figure 13**.
13. Assemble and affix to the shelf following Steps 16-17 on page 2.

14. Remove decoration from cases once the Fair is over.

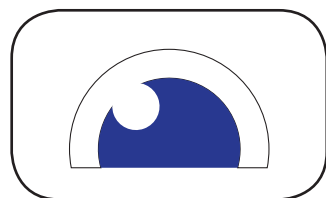

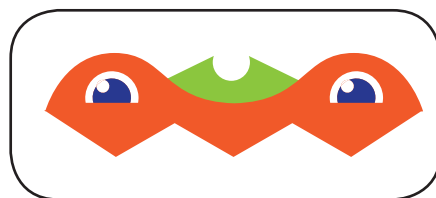

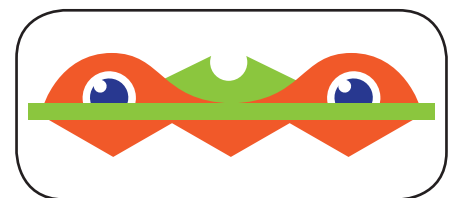
